- 5. What is the over-riding principle in any use of spiritual gifts?
- 6. Have you had any experience with the gifts of prophecy and tongues? If not, are there any similar spiritual gifts that you do know about that could illustrate the same point that Paul is making?
- 7. Are there any spiritual gifts that you would like to learn more about? Why?
- 8. How can the 'way of love' be shown more deeply in our worship at St. Mark's?
